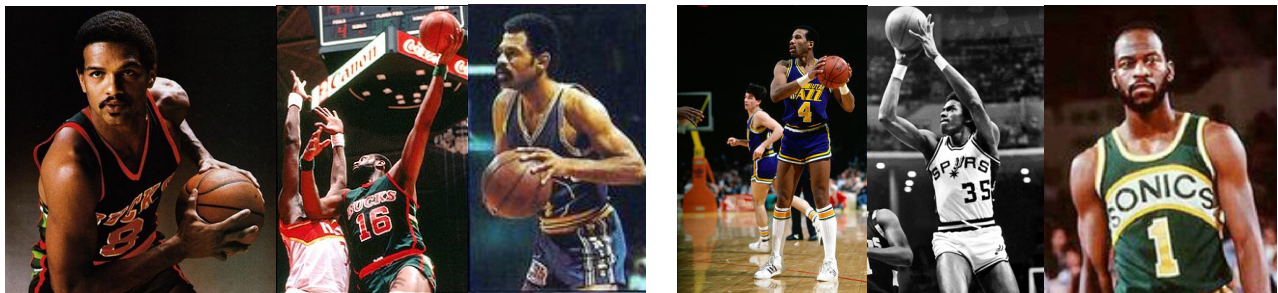




52-37 Robertson Division Champion Callaway Kings
vs
63-24 Havlicek Division Champion Andes Mountaineers

Regular Season: The Callaway Kings were led by Marques Johnson's 21.3 ppg (13th), Bob Lanier's 8.2 rebounds and John Lucas' 6.8 assists (4th). Callaway finished with the 2nd best record in the Eastern Conference and the VBA's 5th best record overall. The Kings' offense generated 115.3 (6th) points per game and their defense allowed 112.3 (10th). The Andes Mountaineers finished as the Eastern Conference's best record, second only in the league to the El Paso Scorpions. Adrian Dantley was 3rd in the VBA with 25.0 avg. Larry Kenon pulled down 8.3 boards per game and Gus Williams dished out 5.2 assists while also scoring 21.9 (9th). The Mountaineers scored 116.2 (5th) per contest and gave up only 104.6 (2nd).



Playoffs: In round one, Marques Johnson tallied 22.4 ppg and also led the Kings with 7.0 rebounds in their win over the San Angelo Bandits. Lucas cranked up a notch, dishing out 8.6 assists in the series. For Andes, Gus Williams led the way with 23.8 points and 4.2 assists. Kenon pulled down 7.8 boards per game against the Providence Steamrollers....

Head-to-head: Andes won all 6 games with Dantley leading the way with a 23.6 average. M.Johnson topped the Kings at 22.0.
